- A variety of films and interactive activities for the entire family

- Elevator access to 75% of all exhibits
- Cafe, gift shop and restrooms

The fully narrated, one hour harbor cruise (North) will show you 12 miles of scenery, the North Island Naval Air Station, Naval Submarine Base, Fort Rosecrans Cemetery, 1863 Star of India and Maritime Museum Vessels, Cabrillo National Monument, Point Loma Lighthouse, and the Sea Lions and Dolphin Training Center.
